AUDITION PROCESS

Auditions for the UMS Choral Union consist of a series of vocalization exercises to determine the range and color of the voice, a prepared solo (16-20 measures), and sight reading of a Bach Chorale. Singers should plan to arrive at least ten minutes prior to the scheduled audition time, and should bring a copy of the prepared solo in the correct key for the accompanist. Singers are notified of the results after completion of all auditions.
