FRAMING CONVERSATIONS AND CREATING AN INCLUSIVE CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENT

- -Be generous

- -focus on actions instead of just words
- -try to correct the behavior
- -Distinguish between comfort and safety
- -Have a clear objective for introducing content and framework for discussing it
- -Build a strong classroom dynamic
 - -require introductory office hour meeting
 - -make sure students know their classmates' names
 - -Do fun weekly check-ins

DEALING WITH HOT MOMENTS

- -Be mindful of small, awkward moments—don't wait for an explosion
- -Don't feel like you have to respond in full right away
 - -practice a response for when things get heated
 - -follow up right away, even if you're still working on your response
