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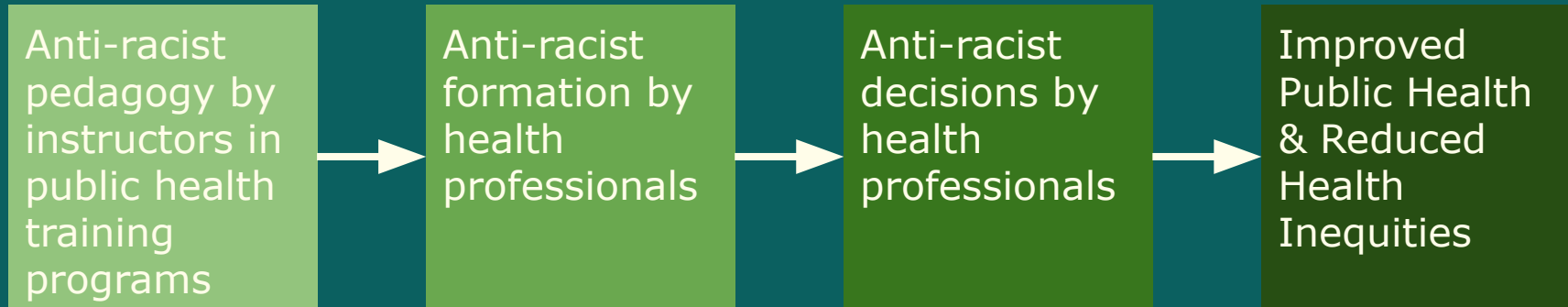
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# Motivation for the Project

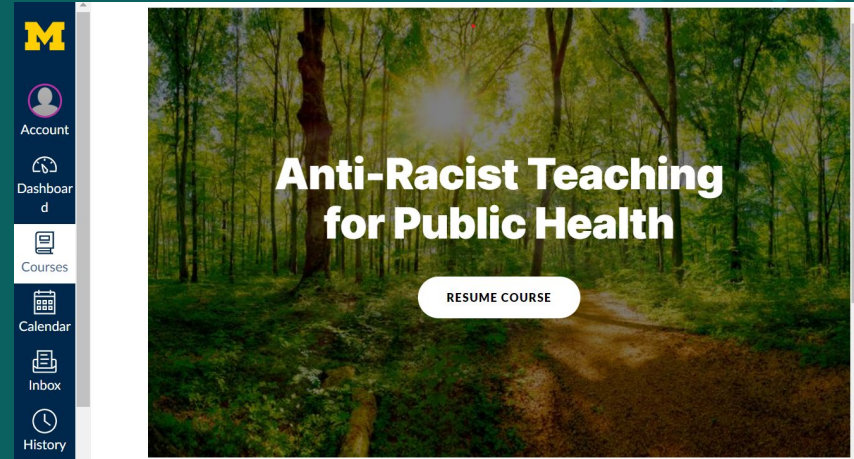
Racial health inequities are a pervasive feature of U.S. society



# What is the project?

## Health Equity via Anti-Racist Teaching

HEART project is aiming to transform the way that Public Health and allied health sciences is taught so that students--who will be the future health professionals--will learn in an anti-racist environment and have an anti-racist toolkit to address inequities.



# Outcomes

## Content creation:

- 8 national steering committee members
- 48 anti-racist teaching videos created
- 5 module webcourse with videos (including animations), readings, and activities

26 currently enrolled UM instructors
